The Allamakee Community School District Board of Education held a Work Session on Thursday, September 7, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. The purpose of the Work Session was to review the First Day Enrollment Count, discuss the Auditorium/Stage Issues and the Waterville Well. The Board reviewed the first day of school enrollment for the 2017-2018 school year as well as enrollment projections for the next year. Mr. Herold updated the Board on the status of the cleanup in the Auditorium. Mr. Herold informed the Board that there is another meeting scheduled with insurance company and he will keep the Board posted on the situation. The Board discussed the Waterville Well. The system is continuing to be monitored and tested. Mr. Hennessy is working with the Department of Natural Resources on short and long-term decisions in regards to the Waterville Well.
